



ALL-STAR INFORMATION



The intent of All Stars is to field strong teams to compete in tournaments in June and possibly early July to play other area league "All-Star" teams or other Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth League teams. Below is some information on how All-Stars will work this season:

1. The WNSL will field All Star teams in each age group of 8U, 10U and 12U. The number of teams will be determined by the number of players that are eligible (by date of birth and ability) to play at this level and the number of coaches willing to commit. Player age as of January 1, 2025 determines which age group the player should play in. A player may play up, but may not play down.
2. Players **MUST BE** current WNSL players on a team for the 2025 Spring Season.
3. Players will be identified by the League through coaches as "All-Star capable" and through a tryout process. Players will be asked to play in All Stars by the League and the All-Star Coaches after a tryout session. All Star Teams will be set in early May.
4. All-Star teams for each division will be formed as "A," "B" and "C" teams.
5. All-Star players may be from one or multiple teams within an age group.
6. **All-Star coaches with daughters playing will have their fees (approximately \$175/player) waived.**
7. Coaches desiring to coach all stars must identify themselves early in the season by informing the league director.
8. All-Star players must commit to play in June possibly through early July. There will be a commitment letter that parents must sign for their child to participate and must pay \$175 to cover uniforms and up to two tournament fees.

WNSL SOFTBALL ALL-STAR Commitment Letter

1. I understand the importance of attending practice, and I will have my player at all practices, games and scrimmages unless a conflict arises. I understand that the head coach must be contacted prior to any absences.
2. I understand that the All-Star season will run from June through early July, and possibly later. Further, I understand that if my daughter cannot be available for tournaments, then she will be considered an alternate team member and not a regular team member.
3. I understand that it is the head coach's decision as to what position each player will play. No one is guaranteed playing time. Playing time is earned through effort, attitude and performance in practices, scrimmages and games.
4. I understand that the equipment, uniform and administrative cost of participating on this All-Star team is \$175.00 per player. This fee must be paid upon making a team. This includes a new uniform. If the player has an "All-Star" uniform, the fee is \$125.
5. I understand that being part of this All-Star team is a privilege and not a right.
6. I understand that this All-Star team is a more intense softball experience in which my player will further develop her softball skills and knowledge of the game. Likewise, I understand that the values of having fun, developing friendships and developing a love for the game are still emphasized.

I have read all of the above and understand the expectations of this Commitment Letter.

Note: Age group is determined by the players age on January 1, 2025

COACHES:

All Star coaches can be regular season coaches, assistant coaches or parents not currently coaching or paid coaches outside the league.

DATES:

Practices in Late May, Tournaments (TBD) in June

COST:

\$175 per player (Includes up to two tournament entry fees and uniforms)

* Coaches kids play all stars for free (Up to Three Coaches per team)

UNIFORMS:

Include jersey, pants, hat, belt and socks

All Players that are average to above average are encouraged to come to the try out. The number of All Star teams is dependent upon Volunteer Coaches we have and the number of qualified players for each age group.

Players that are already on a preformed all star team and these coaches wanting to coach the preformed all star teams are required to attend the appropriate tryout.

There most likely will not be a make up tryout so all players wanting to play all stars should attend these sessions.
